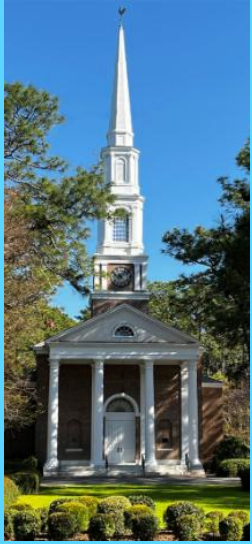




Key Foundation Facts

- Assets at July 31, 2026 topped \$4.1million

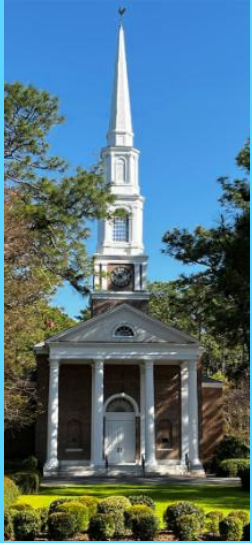




Foundation Stewardship

- Balanced Index Admiral Fund



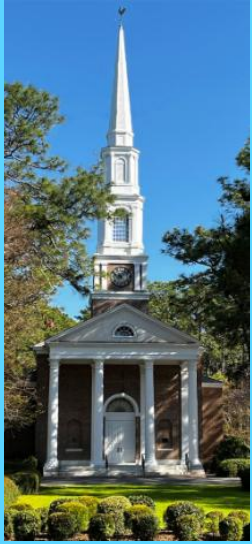


Foundation Stewardship

- Very Low Costs at 0.07%

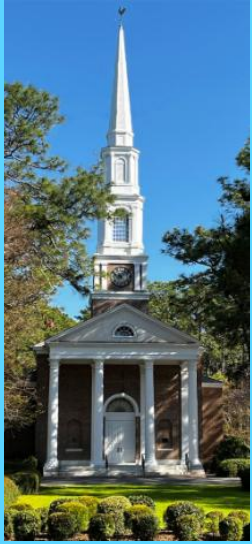




Foundation Governance

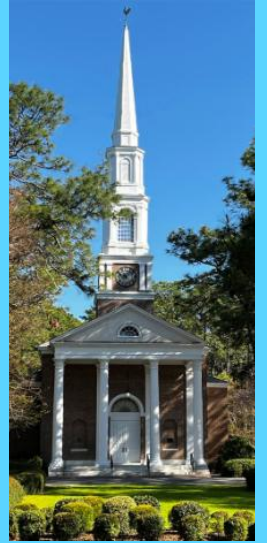

- Foundation Committee is chaired by the Foundation President.





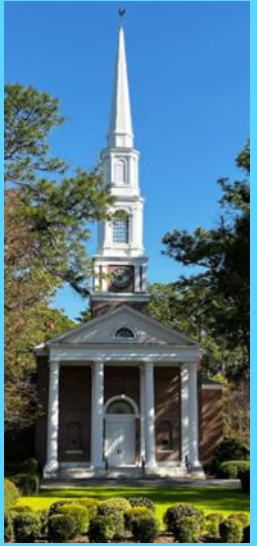

Compliant w/Donor Restrictions

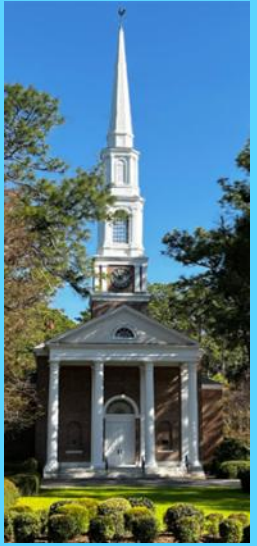
- 29% Missions and Outreach

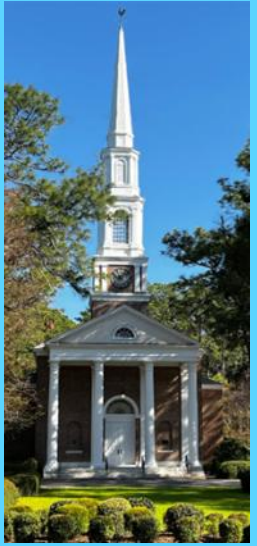
