The National Family Caregiver Support Program (NFCSP) provides grants to States and Territories to fund a range of support that assist caregivers.

What is Respite Care?

Respite care services provide periodic support/relief for caregivers from the responsibilities & stress he/she may encounter while caring for a loved one. It allows the caregiver to practice self-care and meet other responsibilities outside of the home.

The Respite Care Program is based on voluntary contributions only.

Who's eligible for Respite services?

♦ An adult aged 18+ who assists a family member aged 60+

♦ An adult 18+ who assists a person with Dementia/Alzheimer's disease or a cognitive disorder regardless of age

♦ A senior aged 55+ who is a grandparent or other relative (not natural or adoptive parent) raising a grandchild or a family child (aged 0-18)

♦ A senior relative (not natural or adoptive parent) aged 55+ who is raising an adult child aged 18-59 with a disability.

Due to additional grant funding, Caregivers are also eligible to receive the following services:

♦ Liquid Nutrition Supplements (Ensure, Ensure Plus & Glucerna)♦ Incontinence Supplies
